Completed Projects

We're thankful to report the successful completion of several important projects this month. The ladies' parlor septic system has been relocated, paving the way for the phase 2 building project. Roof inspection reports for key buildings have also been completed, giving us a clear understanding of future needs. In addition, the storm doors at the Price and Kendrick houses have been replaced, helping protect and preserve those properties.
