Completed Projects

We're thankful to report that the broken AC unit in the FLC has been repaired and should improve air circulation to resolve the discoloration on the ceiling tiles. The affected tiles are being replaced.

Ongoing Projects

The damaged drain line at the FLC is expected to be repaired July 11th. Once repaired, the FLC kitchen and restrooms will be available for use. A portion of the sidewalk will need to be removed to access the drain line. Until the sidewalk is repaired please use caution when accessing the building. Also, our buildings will be pressure washed soon. If you notice anything in disrepair around the campus or any potential safety hazards please reach out to the diaconate.
