DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★Reading: Romans 1:1-7

★ Questions: How does Paul describe himself?

What do each of these terms mean?

What does the apostle tell us about Jesus in this passage?

★ End with prayer – pray for two unchurched people you know

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 1:1-7

★ Questions: what resources did the apostle have regarding the good news?

What is the role of an apostle?

What does Paul say his goal is?

★ End with prayer – pray for friends, relatives, and neighbors who don't know Jesus.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 1:1-7

★ Questions: Who called us to belong to Christ Jesus?

What is grace? Why is it essential for a child of God?

What is peace? What is its source?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 1:8-15

★ Question: What is faith? How do we get it?

What is Paul's attitude toward prayer?

What is the relationship between service and prayer?

★ End with prayer – pray for the great commission to be fulfilled.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 1:8-15

★ Questions: What is Paul's wish for the Romans? Does this surprise you?

What reason does Paul give for wanting to see the Romans?

Give an example of someone whose faith encourages you.

★ End with prayer – pray for God's help and guidance in sharing Jesus with others.
