★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

Q. 1. Who made you?

A. 1. God.

★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)

Q. 2. What authority from God directs us how to glorify and enjoy him?

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★Reading: Romans 1:28-32

★ Questions: What is human depravity? What do these verses teach about it?

What are several things the culture approves of that God says are wrong?

Why is it easier to respond with condemnation than love to those who struggle with sins we don't share?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 2:1-5

★ Questions: for what sin is Paul condemning the moral person in these verses?

Can we see this behavior in the life of a believer?

What steps can we take to ensure it is not present in us?

★ End with prayer – pray that we will be faithful managers of our time, talent, and treasure.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 2:1-5

★ Questions: Define discernment.

Define judgment.

What is the difference between these two terms?

★ End with prayer – pray for physical health and strength for ourselves, our family, and friends.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 2:6-11

★ Question: On what basis will the Lord bring judgment? Does this surprise you?

What are the four motives for self-righteous judging listed?

What does the presence of these motives reveal about our hearts?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 2:6-11

★ Questions: List the results of following the path of good and evil described in this passage.

What does verse 11 teach about the character of God? How should we respond to this truth?

How do you explain that salvation does not result from doing or being good?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of the ministries of Bethel.
