Day 2

- ★ Reading: Exodus 20:15 (you'll need a copy of the Westminster Larger Catechism to help answer these questions)
- ★ Questions: What is the eighth commandment?

What behaviors/actions are forbidden by it?

What does the eighth commandment require of us?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 3

- ★ Reading: Exodus 20:16 (you'll need a copy of the Westminster Larger Catechism to help answer these questions)
- ★ Questions: What is the ninth commandment?

What behaviors/actions are forbidden by it?

What does the ninth commandment require of us?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of evangelism and discipleship.

Day 4

- ★ Reading: Exodus 20:17 (you'll need a copy of the Westminster Larger Catechism to help answer these questions)
- ★ Questions: What is the tenth commandment?

What behaviors/actions are forbidden by it?

What does the tenth commandment require of us?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in love and compassion towards our neighbors.

Day 5

- ★ Reading: Exodus 20:1-17
- ★ Questions: What are some examples of how Christians break God's commands today?

What is the result of a believer breaking God's rules that we claim to believe?

How can we quard ourselves against sinning?

★ End with prayer – pray for personal renewal of body & spirit.
