- ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children elementary and under)
 - Q. 3. Why did God make you and everything else?
 - A. 3. For His own glory.
 - Q. 4. How can you glorify God?
 - A. 4. By loving Him and doing what He commands.
- ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)
 - Q. 4. What is God?
 - A. 4. God is a spirit, whose being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth are infinite, eternal, and unchangeable.
- ★ Scripture Memory: Psalm 46:1-4

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

Reading: Romans 2:25-29

★ Questions: What is circumcision? What is it a sign of?

How does Paul describe a true Jew? What does this teach us?

Reread these verses, substituting the word baptism for circumcision. What does this teach us about the behavior of visible church members?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 2

- ★ Reading: Romans 3:1-8
- ★ Questions: What question does Paul ask in verse 1? How would you respond to this question? What were the Jewish people entrusted with? What are they?

Whose unrighteousness is Paul referring to in these verses?

★ End with prayer – pray that we will be faithful managers of our time, talent, and treasure.

Day 3

- ★ Reading: Romans 3:1-8
- ★ Questions: What justification does Paul give for God's righteous wrath? Do you agree? Why/why not?

List as many attributes of God as you can. Which attributes would not have been displayed except against the backdrop of sin?

★ End with prayer – pray for physical health and strength for ourselves, our family, and friends.

Day 4

- ★ Reading: Romans 3:1-8
- ★ Question: What is Paul being accused of in verses 7 & 8?

Do people still make this accusation about Christians today? Why/why not?

As Christians, what should our attitude toward sin be? Does our life reflect this truth? Why/why not?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 5

- ★ Reading: Romans 3:9-20
- ★ Questions: Do certain groups of people have a better standing before the Lord than others? Why/why not?

What is the foundational sin which results in the sinful activities listed in verses 13-17? What does it mean to fear God?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of the ministries of Bethel.
