★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

Q. 3. *Why did God make you and everything else?*

A. 3. **For His own glory.**

Q. 4. *How can you glorify God?*

A. 4. **By loving Him and doing what He commands.**

★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)

Q. 4. *What is God?*

A. 4. **God is a spirit, whose being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth are infinite, eternal, and unchangeable.**

★ Scripture Memory: Psalm 46:1-4

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 3:9-20

★ Questions: What are some examples of the sinful behaviors done because we've not been taught to fear God?

Is it possible for the law to save anyone?

What is the purpose of God's law?

★ End with prayer – pray for opportunities to share the gospel with family and friends.

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 3:21-26

★ Questions: Look up the word righteousness. What does it mean?

What can we say about the righteousness of the church in general? Our society?

What is God's answer to our failure to be righteous before Him?

★ End with prayer – pray for the church planting movement in Mexico.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 3:21-26

★ Questions: What does it mean to be "apart from the law"?

What are the three types of law included in the Hebrew Scriptures? What are the three uses of the moral law?

Does everyone receive God's righteousness? How is it applied to people?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in spiritual maturity and personal discipline.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 3:21-26

★ Question: What is involved in belief in Jesus Christ?

Look up the word justification. What does it mean?

What are some examples of God's grace to you over the past week? How should we respond to these gifts?

★ End with prayer – pray to understand better what it means to be "in Christ."

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 3:27-28; James 2:14-16

★ Questions: What kind of faith justifies a person? How can we tell if we have this faith?

What are some things your faith has caused you to do?

How have those around you reacted when you acted on your faith?

★ End with prayer – pray for a greater understanding of God's character and ability.
