DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 3:29-31

★ Questions: What argument does Paul make to prove that God is impartial?

Paul affirms that there is only one God. What does our society tell us?

How might the confusion in our culture allow us to share the gospel with our friends and neighbors?

★ End with prayer – pray for two unchurched people you know

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 3:29-31

★ Questions: Was there ever a time you weren't sure if there was only one God?

How can our history present us with opportunities to share the gospel?

What is antinomianism? Why is it important?

★ End with prayer – pray for friends, relatives, and neighbors who don't know Jesus.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 4:1-5

★ Questions: What reason did Paul have for using Abraham as his example?

What does it mean to be justified by works?

Would anyone have reason to boast if our actions were the cause of our standing before God?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 4:1-5

★ Questions: What does it mean to believe the Lord?

What do you believe about God?

When you work for others, why do you get paid?

★ End with prayer – pray for the great commission to be fulfilled.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 4:1-5

★ Questions: Should someone who does not work get paid as if they do?

How do we feel when something other than this takes place? Why?

What is a gift? What gift does God give those who trust in Him?

★ End with prayer – pray for God's help and guidance in sharing Jesus with others.
