# **★**Suggested Song

All Creatures Of Our God And King

- ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children elementary and under)
  - Q. 5. Why should you glorify God?
  - A. 5. Because He made me and takes care of me.
  - Q. 6. Is there more than one God?
  - A. 6. There is only one God.
- ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)
  - Q. 6. How many persons are in the one God?
  - A. 6. Three persons are in the one God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are one God, the same in substance, and equal in power and glory.
- ★ Scripture Memory: Psalm 46:1-7

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. Selah. There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved; God will help her when morning dawns. #### Day 1

- ★ Reading: Romans 5:1-11
- ★ Questions: Why is the phrase 'at just the right time' included in verse 6?

What is foreordination?

How does foreordination apply in this passage?

 $\star$  End with prayer – pray for opportunities to share the gospel with family and friends.

## Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 5:1-11

★ Questions: Why were we still powerless?

What does this remind us of our own ability?

In verses 6-8, what three words does Paul use to describe the condition of the people for whom Christ died? Define these words.

★ End with prayer – pray for the church planting movement in Mexico.

## Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 5:1-11

★ Questions: From our perspective, why does it seem illogical that the Lord should send His

Son to die on our behalf?

Compare and contrast verse 8 with John 15:13.

Can you name a righteous leader who offered to give his life for an unrighteous person? Why does this not happen?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in spiritual maturity and personal discipline.

# Day 4

★ Reading: Ephesians 2:1-10

★ Question: Why is a person powerless to save themselves?

How does Paul tell us we are saved in this passage? Why is this important?

What reasons do these verses give for our salvation?

★ End with prayer – pray to understand better what it means to be "in Christ."

# Day 5

★ Reading: 1Thessalonians 1:2-10

★ Questions: What good works has God called you to perform?

What is the wrath of God?

Do you really believe those without Christ will face the wrath of God? How should we respond to this reality?

★ End with prayer – pray for a greater understanding of God's character and ability.
