★ Suggested Song

What A Friend We Have in Jesus

★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

Q. 5. Why should you glorify God?

A. 5. Because He made me and takes care of me.

Q. 6. Is there more than one God?

A. 6. There is only one God.

★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)

Q. 6. How many persons are in the one God?

A. 6. Three persons are in the one God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are one God, the same in substance, and equal in power and glory.

★ Scripture Memory: Psalm 46:1-7

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. Selah. There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved; God will help her when morning dawns. The nations rage, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts. The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. Selah"

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 5:1-11

★ Questions: What is an enemy? When were we in that position in relationship to God?

Using verse 10 and Hebrews 7:25, explain the death and life of Jesus.

Define reconciliation. Is reconciliation necessary in the life of a Christian? In the life of a local congregation? Why/why not?

★ End with prayer – pray for two unchurched people you know

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 5:12-14; Genesis 8:21; Ephesians 2:3

★ Questions: What do the Scriptures teach about the spiritual state of a newborn human? What does the world teach us about a baby's natural state? Do these agree?

How did sin enter the world? What does this mean for us?

What is the result of sin? What does this mean for us?

★ End with prayer – pray for friends, relatives, and neighbors who don't know Jesus.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 5:15-17

★ Questions: What are some ways sin brings physical and spiritual death to people today?

List the contrasts between Adam and Jesus in this passage.

How does Paul use the term 'gift' here? What are the results of condemnation? Of life in Christ?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 5:18-19

★ Questions: What trespass is Paul referring to in these verses?

According to the apostle, what is the result of this trespass?

How is this possible?

★ End with prayer – pray for the great commission to be fulfilled.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 5:18-20

★ Questions: Does Paul's teaching here seem fair to you? Why/why not?

Does Paul teach the universal salvation of all humanity? Why/why not?

What three types of law were given to Israel by God?

★ End with prayer – pray for God's help and guidance in sharing Jesus with others.
