#### ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

*Q. 6. How many persons are in the one God?*

**A. 6. Three persons.**

*Q. 7. Who are they?*

**A. 7. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.**

#### ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)

*Q. 7. What are the decrees of God?*

**A. 7. The decrees of God are His eternal plans based on the purpose of His will, by which, for His own glory, He has foreordained everything that happens.**

#### ★ Scripture Memory: Psalm 46:1-7

*"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. Selah. There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved; God will help her when morning dawns. The nations rage, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts. The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. Selah"*

### DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

#### Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 5:18-20

★ Questions: What are the three continuing uses of the moral law?

For what reason does Paul tell us the law was given? Why is this important?

How does adding laws increase sin? What is the result of this?

★ End with prayer – pray for two unchurched people you know

## Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 5:21

★ Questions: What two kingdoms does Paul introduce to us in this verse?

What are the results of belonging to each kingdom?

Who are some individuals you should be telling about these two kingdoms?

★ End with prayer – pray for friends, relatives, and neighbors who don't know Jesus.

## Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 4:1-5

★ Questions: What reason did Paul have for using Abraham as his example?

What does it mean to be justified by works?

Would anyone have reason to boast if our actions were the cause of our standing before God?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

## Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 6:1-2

★ Questions: What does it mean to be an antinomian? How does it apply to verse 1?

Have you ever been tempted to sin? Please share your experience with the group.

What is Paul's aim in asking these questions in verse 1?

★ End with prayer – pray for the great commission to be fulfilled.

## Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 6:1-2

★ Questions: The apostle uses the word "we" four times here. Who is he talking about?

What does the Bible teach us is the first step of living a Christian life?

How do we die to sin? What tools has God given us to help in this work?

★ End with prayer – pray for God's help and guidance in sharing Jesus with others.
