- ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children elementary and under)
 - Q. 6. How many persons are in the one God?
 - A. 6. Three persons.

- ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

- ★ Reading: Romans 6:3-4
- ★ Questions: According to these verses, what Has Christ's death and resurrection accomplished? What is baptism? What is it a sign and seal of?

How is Jesus' life today different from His life before the cross?

★ End with prayer – pray for people serving in local, state, and national government.

Day 2

- ★ Reading: Ephesians 4:22-24; Colossians 3:1-17
- ★ Questions: What does it mean to be united to Christ?

How should our lives be different because of our union with Christ?

What are you doing each day to seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 6:5-10

★ Questions: What is joy?

What reasons do we have for joy as believers, according to Paul?

What is our old self? What are we supposed to be doing with it?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of evangelism and discipleship.

Day 4

- ★ Reading: Romans 6:5-10
- ★ Questions: What does it mean to be a slave to sin?

Why should this behavior no longer be a part of our lives?

How do you live for Christ in your relationships today?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in love and compassion towards our neighbors.

Day 5

- ★ Reading: Romans 6:11
- ★ Questions: How does Paul use the term count? What are we supposed to count ourselves?

What is the difference between counting something and knowing it?

What is Paul urging us to do here?

★ End with prayer – pray for personal renewal of body & spirit.
