★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

★ Scripture Memory: Romans 10:9-10

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 6:12-14

★ Questions: What four responses does Paul tell us we should have in this passage?

What specific examples can you give for how sin is to be refused?

What does it mean that we are not under law but under grace?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 6:15-16

★ Questions: Why does Paul ask these questions in verse 15?

Do you know anyone who has offered themselves as slaves to sin? What does this teach us?

What are some specific parts of the body that fall prey to sin? Why is this?

★ End with prayer – pray that we will be faithful managers of our time, talent, and treasure.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 6:17-18

★ Questions: Why is wholehearted obedience important for the Christian?

What does wholehearted obedience demonstrate to ourselves? To others?

What are the risks we face when we obey halfheartedly?

★ End with prayer – pray for physical health and strength for ourselves, our family, and friends.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 6:17-18

★ Question: How are we set free from sin?

List as many advantages as you can of being a slave to righteousness.

Are there any drawbacks to being a slave to righteousness? Why/why not?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 6:19-22

★ Questions: What does it mean to speak in human terms?

What are some of our natural inclinations?

What does becoming a slave to righteousness lead to?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of the ministries of Bethel.
