★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

Q. 6. How many persons are in the one God?

A. 6. Three persons.

★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)

Q. 8. How does God carry out His decrees?

★ Scripture Memory: review Psalm 46:1-7

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. Selah. There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved; God will help her when morning dawns. The nations rage, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts. The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. Selah"

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 6:19-22

★ Questions: As Christians, what freedoms should we work to achieve in the world?

What are some things from which you would like to be free?

Why is autonomy not true freedom?

★ End with prayer – pray for opportunities to share the gospel with family and friends.

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 6:23

★ Questions: What are wages?

How is a salary different than a gift?

How much did the gift cost us? How much did it cost the Lord?

★ End with prayer – pray for the church planting movement in Mexico.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 6:23

★ Questions: What does Paul mean by the use of the word death here?

Explain in your own words how the wages of sin is death.

How would you explain to a neighbor that the gift of God is eternal life?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in spiritual maturity and personal discipline.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 6:23

★ Question: What is sanctification?

Who plays a role in the process of growing holiness? How long does it last?

Why don't we live a consistent godly lifestyle? How can we emphasize it more in our lives?

★ End with prayer – pray to understand better what it means to be "in Christ."

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 7:1-6

★ Questions: To whom is Paul writing in these verses? Why is this important?

Who knows the law? Which law is the apostle referring to in these verses?

How did we die to the law? How long does the law exercise authority over us?

★ End with prayer – pray for a greater understanding of God's character and ability.
