**Catechism Question: (3/4)**

Children's Catechism

Q. 31. What was the sin of our first parents?

A. Eating the forbidden fruit.

Q. 32. Who tempted them to this sin?

A. The devil tempted Eve, and she gave the fruit to Adam.

Shorter Catechism

Q40. What rules did God first reveal for man to obey?

A. The rules He first revealed were the moral law.

Q41. Where is the moral law summarized?

A. The moral law is summarized in the ten commandments.

**DAILY DEVOTIONS**

**Day 1 (Sunday April 19, 2026)**

Reading: II Kings 24-25

Questions:

- What new king and what union of nations came against Judah? What was God's purpose in this new threat?
- What happened to the treasures in the Temple?
- Along with Nebuchadnezzar's siege of Jerusalem, what else happened to distress the city?

Prayer for: Matt 6 – That God's name (and person) not be used carelessly, but be worshipped and glorified.

**Day 2 - Monday**

Reading: I Chron 1

Questions:

- What is the purpose / theme of the first chapter of the book of Chronicles?
- What major Biblical persons are named?
- What other major lineages – besides Israel's – are named?

Prayer for: Matt 9: 38 – that God send laborers into His harvest

**Day 3 - Tuesday**

Reading: I Chron 2-3

Questions:

- Who is named as David's forefather, at the beginning of chapter 2?
- What does the naming of sisters, wives and mothers (E.g., 2: 16- 19 ) tell us about God?
- What does the naming of a slave (2: 34-35) in David's lineage tell us about God?
- Why do you think ch. 3 has such a detailed lineage of David?

Prayer for: I Thess 4:13 – that we would be sanctified, and keep ourselves from immorality

#### **Day 4 - Wednesday**

Reading: I Chron 4

Questions:

- Who were Judah and Simeon?
- Why are their descendants names?

Prayer for: I Pet 4:2 – that we no longer love to fulfil the desires of the flesh, but rather to do God's will

#### **Day 5 - Thursday**

Reading: I Chron 5

Questions:

- What does chapter 5 give us as the reason for Reuben, birthright being given to Joseph?
- What other sons of Jacob (and their descendants) are named in ch, 5?

Prayer for: Matt 6: 33 To seek God's kingdom above all else, and wait on Him for everything else.

#### **Day 6 - Friday**

Reading: I Chron 6

Questions:

- Which son of Jacob's does ch. 6 focus on?
- What tribe was Moses from?
- What was the job David gave (6:31) to these sons of Levi? What does 6:48 says was the work given all the sons of Levi?

Prayer for: For the effectiveness of Bethel's ministries

#### **Day 7 - Saturday**

Reading: I Chron 7-8

Questions:

- Which sons of Jacob does chapter 7 focus on?
- Whose genealogy is the focus of chapter 8?
- Why is Saul's genealogy important?

Prayer for: Isa 26:3 – God keep our minds focused on Him, and give us His peace.
