Day 1

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 7:4-6

★ Questions: What is sanctification?

What is justification?

How are these two things similar? How are they different?

★ End with prayer – pray for friends, relatives, and neighbors who don't know Jesus.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 7:7-13

★ Questions: What is sin? How are we made aware of it?

What are some good things the law does in the life of a Christian?

What are some ways sin has deceived you? What were the results of this deception?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 7:14-25

★ Questions: Explain how the law is spiritual. Can a true child of God be of the flesh?

What does it mean to be sold under sin?

Is Paul describing his life before or after conversion? Why?

★ End with prayer – pray for the great commission to be fulfilled.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 7:14-25

★ Questions: Can you think of professing Christians who seem to be controlled by sin?

What is our responsibility to them?

How do we guard our hearts against judgmentalism?

★ End with prayer – pray for God's help and guidance in sharing Jesus with others.
