- ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children elementary and under)
 - Q. 9. What is God?
 - A. 9. God is a Spirit and does not have a body.
 - Q. 10. Where is God?
 - A. 10. God is everywhere.
 - Q. 11. Can you see God?
 - A. 11. No. I cannot see God, but He always sees me.
- ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)
 - Q. 10. How did God create man?
 - A. 10. God created man, male and female, in his own image, and in knowledge, righteousness, and holiness, to rule over the other creatures.
- ★ Scripture Memory: 1 John 4:7-9

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

- ★ Reading: John 8:31-47
- ★ Questions: What does it mean to be adopted by God?

Who is the father of those whom the Lord does not adopt?

What are some aspects of our inheritance as children of God?

 \star End with prayer – pray for opportunities to share the gospel with family and friends.

Day 2

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:18
- ★ Questions: What are some of the sufferings of the present age?

Why would Paul expect his readers to listen to his teaching on this subject?

What insight into time do we see present here? Why is this important?

★ End with prayer – pray for the church planting movement in Mexico.

Day 3

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:18
- ★ Questions: Why do Christians suffer? Is this all a result of our faith?

Have you ever suffered for Christ? What effect did it have?.

What is the glory to be revealed in us? How does God display His glory?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in spiritual maturity and personal discipline.

Day 4

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:19-21
- ★ Question: Describe what Paul means by creation in verse 19. How does this contrast with the sons of God in the same verse?

Who are the sons of God?

Why is creation longing for them to be revealed?

★ End with prayer – pray to understand better what it means to be "in Christ."

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 8:19-21

Questions: Why was creation subjected to futility?

How did this happen?

What are several ways you see the frustration of creation in daily life?

★ End with prayer – pray for a greater understanding of God's character and ability.
