#### ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

*Q. 12. Does God know everything?*

**A. 12. Yes. Nothing can be hidden from God.**

*Q. 13. Can God do everything?*

**A. 13. Yes. God can do all His holy will.**

*Q. 14. Where do you learn how to love and obey God?*

**A. 14. Only in the Bible.**

#### ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)

*Q. 11. What is God's providence?*

**A. 11. God's providence is His completely holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing every creature and every action.**

#### ★ Scripture Memory: 1 John 4:7-10

*"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins."*

### DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

#### Day 1

★ Reading: 2 Peter 3:13; Revelation 21:1

★ Questions: When will the created realm be freed from its bondage to sin?

How will creation be freed from its slavery?

Is it essential as Christians for us to care about the created realm?

★ End with prayer – pray for two unchurched people you know

## Day 2

★ Reading: 2 Peter 3:13; Revelation 21:1

★ Questions: How are we supposed to care for the natural world?

As Christians, what is our responsibility to protect the environment?

What point in these passages spoke to you the most? What did it change about you?

★ End with prayer – pray for friends, relatives, and neighbors who don't know Jesus.

## Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 8:22-26

★ Questions: In this passage, what three entities groan?

What is the reason for each one's complaint?

What are the first fruits? How does Paul often use this term?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

## Day 4

★ Reading: John 8:22-25

★ Questions: What is hope?

As believers, for what do we hope?

According to Paul, how are we supposed to wait?

★ End with prayer – pray for the great commission to be fulfilled.

## Day 5

★ Reading: John 8:22-25

★ Questions: Why don't we like to wait for God?

What are some things for which you are currently waiting and hoping?

Why do you think God included this passage in the Bible?

★ End with prayer – pray for God's help and guidance in sharing Jesus with others.
