 - A. 11. God's providence is His completely holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing every creature and every action.
- ★ Scripture Memory: 1 John 4:7-10

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:26-27
- ★ Questions: What are some of the ministries of the holy Spirit?

Besides the Holy Spirit, who is praying for you today? How do you know this?

Why is the ministry of intercession so vital to us as Christians?

★ End with prayer – pray for people serving in local, state, and national government.

Day 2

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:28-30
- ★ Questions: In light of events going on around us, how can verse 28 be true?

What essential qualification does God give in this verse?

How does this qualification clarify what Paul is teaching in this verse?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 3

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:28-30
- ★ Questions: List some things that Christians suffer today that are often seen as "bad."

Can God use these things for good? How?

What should we do when we can't understand how God can use the trials we face for our good?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of evangelism and discipleship.

Day 4

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:28-30
- ★ Questions: What does it mean to be predestined?

According to the apostle, what are we predestined to?

What does it mean to be conformed?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in love and compassion towards our neighbors.

Day 5

- ★ Reading: Romans 8:28-30
- ★ Questions: List the ways God shapes His people into the image of Jesus?

How are you being conformed into the image of Christ today? How do you know?

What are the personal characteristics of Jesus Christ?

★ End with prayer – pray for personal renewal of body & spirit.
