★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children *elementary and under*)

Q. 12. Does God know everything?

A. 14. Only in the Bible.

Q. 11. What is God's providence?

A. 11. God's providence is His completely holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing every creature and every action.

★ Scripture Memory: 1 John 4:7-10

"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

★ Reading: Romans 8:31-35

★ Questions: List the questions Paul asks the readers in these verses.

Are these questions rhetorical? Why/why not?

Write out your answers to these questions.

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 2

★ Reading: John 8:31-35

★ Questions: In what ways is God for us as His people?

Why is the resurrection important? Where is Jesus right now?

What is Christ doing for you right now? How does this comfort you?

★ End with prayer – pray that we will be faithful managers of our time, talent, and treasure.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 8:36-37

★ Questions: What is the relationship between Christ's intercession and the eternal security of the elect?

Why does Paul quote Psalm 44 here?

How does the love of Christ enable us to be conquerors?

★ End with prayer – pray for physical health and strength for ourselves, our family, and friends.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 8:38-39

★ Question: List the things that Paul tells us cannot separate us from the love of God.

What brings about short-term separation from our Heavenly Father?

What are some things that come between you and your friends or family?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 8:38-39

★ Questions: How do the issues that separate you from your friends also separate you from God?

Which of God's attributes have stood out to you in your recent readings? Why?

Why do you think the Lord included these verses in the Bible?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of the ministries of Bethel.
