- ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children elementary and under)
 - Q. 12. Does God know everything?
 - A. 12. Yes. Nothing can be hidden from God.
 - Q. 13. Can God do everything?
 - A. 13. Yes. God can do all His holy will.
 - Q. 14. Where do you learn how to love and obey God?
 - A. 14. Only in the Bible.
- ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)
 - Q. 12. What did God's providence specifically do for man whom he created?
 - A. 12. After the creation, God made a covenant with man to give him life if he perfectly obeyed. God told him not to eat from the tree of knowledge of good and evil, or he would die.
- ★ Scripture Memory: 1 John 4:7-11

"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this, the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:1-5
- ★ Questions: What two witnesses does Paul mention in verse 1?

How does the Bible define 'conscience'?

Why did Paul emphasize he was telling the truth?

 \star End with prayer – pray for opportunities to share the gospel with family and friends.

Day 2

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:1-5
- ★ Questions: What is the risk of not using both witnesses to which Paul refers in verse 1?

What are some reasons Paul feels so strongly about the Jews?

Is there anyone for whom you would trade your place in heaven if you could?

★ End with prayer – pray for the church planting movement in Mexico.

Day 3

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:3; 1 Corinthians 12:3; Galatians 1:8-9
- ★ Questions: In these verses, what does the term 'cursed' mean?

Is it possible for Paul to suffer condemnation for the Jewish people?

Why is it impossible for us to trade our eternal destiny with anyone else?

★ End with prayer – pray for growth in spiritual maturity and personal discipline.

Day 4

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:1-5
- ★ Questions: In verses 4 & 5, what characteristics separate Israel and the world? What does each of these things mean?

What spiritual advantages has God given you? Why did he give you these things? Who were the biblical patriarchs? Where did they live?

★ End with prayer – pray to gain a deeper understanding of what it means to be "in Christ."

Day 5

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:1-5
- ★ Questions: When did the patriarchs walk the earth? What did they do for a living?

Do you have any ancestors who have influenced your spiritual journey?

What does verse 5 tell us about Jesus?

★ End with prayer – pray for a greater understanding of God's character and ability.
