- ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children elementary and under)
  - Q. 15. Who wrote the Bible?
  - A. 15. Chosen men who were guided by the Holy Spirit.
  - Q. 16. Who were our first parents?
  - A. 16. Adam and Eve.
  - Q. 17. What were our first parents made of?
  - A. 17. God made Adam's body out of the earth, and He made Eve from Adam's body.
- ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)
  - Q. 13. Did our first parents remain as they were created?
  - A. 13. Left to the freedom of their own wills, our first parents sinned against God and fell from their original condition.
- ★ Scripture Memory: 1 John 4:7-12

"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us."

#### DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

# Day 1

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:13-18; Malachi 1:1-4
- ★ Questions: In these verses, what does it teach us about Esau and Pharoah?

What was God's reason for choosing to harden Pharaoh's heart?

What is Paul's view of the OT, as demonstrated here? Why is this important?

★ End with prayer – pray for two unchurched people you know

## Day 2

- ★ Reading: Exodus 5
- ★ Questions: What reasons are given for God's justice in passing over Pharaoh?

What does God make His choices based upon? Is this good news? Why/why not?

Do the Scriptures teach that all people are God's children? Why/why not?

★ End with prayer – pray for friends, relatives, and neighbors who don't know Jesus.

## Day 3

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:19-24
- ★ Questions: What are some ways people question God's fairness?

What does it say about someone when they say God is not fair?

Paul compares us to clay in these verses. Is this a fair comparison? When does it fall short?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

# Day 4

- ★ Reading: James 1:13-15
- ★ Questions: Does God cause man to sin? Does God tempt us?

Where does temptation come from?

What do the Scriptures teach about our ability to resist temptation?

★ End with prayer – pray for the great commission to be fulfilled.

### Day 5

- ★ Reading: Romans 9:19-24
- ★ Questions: If God saved people based on something he saw in them, would this be just? Why / why not?

Why has God patiently endured the objects of his wrath?

What does the doctrine of election mean to you daily? How does it help your feelings of assurance?

★ End with prayer – pray for God's help and quidance in sharing Jesus with others.
